

PROCEEDINGS SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING ON CURRENT & FUTURE
EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS

January 31st, 2018

The Alden City Council met in special session on Wednesday, January 31st, 2018 at 5:00 PM, to discuss the city's current and future employment positions.
