

PUBLIC HEARING - PROPOSED ASSESSMENTS
2017 STREET & ALLEY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

October 25th, 2017

The Alden City Council held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, October 25th, 2017 at 6:00 PM to consider, and possibly adopt, the proposed assessment for the 2017 Street & Alley Improvement project on Morin Road: from Washington Ave. to the southern cul-de-sac, the West Alley of Broadway Street: all lots and parcels of land from Main Street to Broadway Street, and the East Alley of Broadway Street: all lots and parcels of land from Main Street to Water Street

Present was Mayor Reyerson, Councilmembers Duncan, Riebe, VanEngelenburg and Wichmann. City Employees: Wuerflein and Scholten. Also present were Wes Brown of Bolton & Menk, Ben Rosol of Bolton & Menk, as well as many community members. Councilmember Wichmann was absent.

Mayor Reyerson called the Public Hearing to order.

Wes Brown gave a presentation explaining the assessment process, scope of the overall project, as well as project costs and funding.

There were many questions with lengthy discussion regarding the final assessments, as well as completion of the project.

Motion by Riebe, second by Duncan, and carried to approve and adopt the following resolution: RESOLUTION ADOPTING ASSESSMENT 2017 STREET & ALLEY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. The full resolution will be on file in the City Clerk's Office.
